An introduction of Directors, Staff and participants was held. It was acknowledged that quorum was met for the AGM. Elder Charlie Catholique performed an opening prayer.

The Objectives of the Society as established under the Environmental Agreement were summarized and it was confirmed that the AGM is being conducted in accordance with the requirements of IEMA's Bylaws.

### Presentation of IEMA's Annual Report

The presentation provided a summary of the Agency's 2022-2023 Annual Report. This included a review of Agency activities and documents that were reviewed between April 2022 and March 2023. The presentation also reviewed the Agency's recommendations to the company (Arctic Canadian Diamond Company) and GNWT Department of Lands along with individual assessments of the company and various regulators that the Agency worked with throughout the year. Agency Directors provided clarification on specific recommendations and heard feedback from the company, the GNWT and Society Members on topics related to Traditional Knowledge gathering, reclamation activities and landfill waste management.

The Agency's Secretary Treasurer reviewed the 2022-2023 Audited Financial Statement and the 2023-2024 Work Plan and budget.

### Arctic Canadian Diamond Company Ltd - Presentation by Glen Swanson

Arctic Canadian provided an update of the company's current operations and changes to their ownership (Burgundy Diamond Mines) and staff, including internal organization structure and those new to the company. Arctic Canadian discussed their upcoming plans to extend the mine life of Ekati, with their plans to submit an application for a Water Licence. Following the presentation, Arctic Canadian answered questions about the company's plans for future developments at Ekati, progressive reclamation and the use of Traditional Knowledge in project applications.

#### **Other Business**

Laurie McGregor shared updates from the GNWT regarding the Minister's decision on the Water Licence Renewal, the 2022 Environmental Impact Report, and the Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan update. She also encouraged all participants to share their concerns and recommendations to the WLWB through the Online Review System to ensure they are considered during reviews.
