Work Plan and Core Budget 2012-14

- Core budget fixed by Resolution Agreements and grows with cost of living
- Separate Fund is part of core funding for Agency participation in public hearings
- Additional funding can be requested
- Agency has independence over work plan, not subject to BHPB or government approval
- 2012-13 and 2013-14 work plan and budget prepared based on Agency mandate



Key Agency Activities

- Board Meetings
- Document Review
- Separate Fund activities (public hearings)
- Consultation and Communication
- Outside Contracts
- Management and Administration



Board Meetings

- Main way to meet our mandate
- 4 meetings per year, plus conference calls if needed
- One board meeting a year held in a community
- Meetings are open to all Society Members
- Guests invited to provide updates and receive input



Review of Documents

- Agency regularly reviews documents on:
 - Wildlife
 - Aquatics (including special reports, e.g. Panda Diversion Channel)
 - Air Quality
 - Annual Environmental Reports
 - Closure and Reclamation (e.g. Annual Progress Reports)



Separate Fund Activities

- Agency interventions in regulatory and other legal processes
- For 2012-13
 - Ekati water licence renewal (current licence expires August 2013)
 - Hearing to be held February 12-13, 2013



Consultation and Communication

- Community visits, including one Board meeting and open house per year held in a community
 - Visited Whati in September 2012 (follow-up brochure distributed)
- Regular updates and summaries of Directors' meetings distributed by e-mail
- AGM and Xmas Open House
- Posters and pamphlets revised and produced in all Aboriginal languages (Chipewyan, Inuinnaqtun, Tlicho, Weledeh) English and French
- Sound files in same languages to be posted to Agency's website



Consultation and Communication

- Annual Report (technical, plain language, summary brochure)
- Website and Timeline Project
- Communications Strategy completed
- Newsletter restarted (March 2012 and November 2012)
- Recruited second staff position
- Resource library (photos and slides scanned)

Outside Contracts

- Agency sometimes uses outside expertise
- Help review reports, studies and plans for topics where Agency Directors may not have experience
 - Closure and Reclamation
 - Air Quality
 - Seepage and Waste Rock Management
 - Aquatics



Management and Administration

- Office in Yellowknife (rent, equipment, supplies, cleaning, insurance, phone, fax, internet—Agency has taken over all services)
- Staff: Executive Director and Communications and Environmental Specialist (salaries and benefits, professional development)
- Accounting and audit fees



Technical Focus for 2012-14

Closure and Reclamation

- Review of Annual Progress Reports
- Financial security review now that ICRP approved

Water Licence Renewal

- Review of all effluent quality criteria and monitoring results (some new variables may need to be regulated, e.g. nitrate and chloride)
- Need for Response Framework (adaptive management)



Technical Focus for 2012-14

Wildlife

 Review of further monitoring program changes (camera reports, wolverine and grizzly bear DNA hair snagging, possibly improved caribou monitoring)

Environmental Impact Report 2012

- Greatly improved
- Stronger focus on important current issues, trends and adaptive management
