Submission of the BHPBilliton EKATI Diamond Mine, 2005 Environmental RE: Annual Report for the Environment Agreement

Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) has received BHPBilliton's 2005 Environmental Annual Report which was received on July 11, 2006. As per the Environmental Agreement the Minister may after consultation with the parties apply Sections 5.1(c)or 5.1(d) to his report.

The Environmental Agreement (Article V, Reporting Requirements, Section 5.1(c)) states that "within forty-five (45) days of the receipt by The Government of the Northwest Territories(GNWT), the Monitoring Agency and the Aboriginal Peoples of the Annual Report, the GNWT, the Monitoring Agency and the Aboriginal Peoples may advise the Minister whether such Annual Report is unsatisfactory; including whether the information provided is adequate as well as whether or not remedial actions taken or proposed in respect of impact or compliance problems are satisfactory".

Section 5.1(d) states that "within ninety (90) days of the receipt of the Annual Report, the Minister may advise BHPBilliton whether such Annual Report is satisfactory or whether the Minister has determined that (including based on reports from the GNWT, the Monitoring Agency and/or the Aboriginal Peoples and including whether the information provided is adequate as well as whether or not remedial actions taken or proposed in respect of impact or compliance problems are satisfactory) such Annual Report is deficient".



INAC is requesting that all parties, as per the distribution list, forward their comments on the BHPBilliton 2005 Environmental Annual Report to Lionel Marcinkoski by August 4, 2006 and indicate whether the report is satisfactory or unsatisfactory.
