ENR Proposal for Management Actions for the Bathurst Caribou Herd

On December 15, 2006, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) submitted a proposal to the Wek earlii Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) outlining proposed management actions to reduce harvesting and collect accurate harvest information on the Bathurst Caribou Herd.

The WRRB has decided to conduct a public hearing before making any decisions on management actions for barren-ground caribou management within Wek'eezhii. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information from ENR regarding its proposal and allow participants an opportunity to express their views on barren-ground caribou management within Wek'eezhii.
