We would further suggest inviting Graham Veale the Air Quality Program Coordinator at ENR and Dave Fox the Air Pollution Management Analyst at Environment Canada to attend. We are in the midst of discussing the air program with these agencies and would be pleased to have your groups input during these discussions.
