The Directors of the Independent Environmental Monitoring Agency would like to express our appreciation for the outstanding work that ENR has conducted in the past in advancing the state of knowledge on the ecology of the Bathurst caribou herd.

While we regret the upcoming retirement and loss of the department's most experienced caribou scientist, we urge ENR to carry on its mandate and duty to continue research and monitoring of the Bathurst caribou herd. These efforts contribute to the design of a regional cumulative effects monitoring system for the herd--a priority for all of our Aboriginal society members. We suggest that ENR ensure adequate resources are made available to continue this work in an effective way, particularly for locating a suitable new ungulate biologist in a timely manner to allow your team to fulfill its mandate.
